## **Schedule 1 Scope of Authorisation**

The authorisation granted to **Credit Agricole CIB – QFC Branch** to carry on the regulated activity of Arranging Credit Facilities is restricted to the following specified product:

(a) Credit Facilities.

The authorisation granted to Credit Agricole CIB – QFC Branch to carry on the regulated activity of Arranging Deals in Investments and Advising on Investments is restricted to the following specified products:

- (a) Shares;
- (b) Debt Instruments;
- (c) Warrants;
- (d) Securities Receipts;
- (e) Units in a Collective Investment Fund;
- (f) Options;
- (g) Futures;
- (h) Contracts for Differences;
- (i) Rights in investments.
